- ∞ Of good moral character and have a positive "can do" attitude.
- ∞ Available for various appearances throughout the state, primarily on weekends. (We are flexible with the titleholders for school and family events, but expect her to uphold her duties as Miss Hunt County's Outstanding Teen.)
